## Directions

*Oxbow Golf Club in Belpre, Ohio*

**From the West:** Traveling east on US Rt. 50 and Ohio Rts. 7 and 32. Exit onto Ohio Rt. 339. Turn left (North toward Beverly) and drive approximately 1.8 miles to Washington County Road 85 (just past the Belpre Animal Clinic on the right). Turn right on CR 85.

**From the East:** Traveling west on US 50 and Ohio Rts. 7 and 32. Exit onto Ohio Rt. 339. Turn right (North toward Beverly) and drive approximately 1.7 miles to Washington County Road 85 (just past the Belpre Animal Clinic on the right). Turn right on CR 85.

**From the North:** Traveling south on Ohio Rt. 339. It is about 6.4 miles from the intersection of SR 339 and SR 550 to Washington County Road 85. Turn left on CR 85.


### **For everyone after you get to Washington County Road 85:**

You'll see the golf course within 1/2 mile of turning onto CR 85. Follow CR 85 for about 1.2 miles (you'll cross a little bridge and bear seriously left). Turn right into Oxbow and follow the road until you come to the clubhouse. You can't go any farther on that road. Watch the speed bumps!

## Tony Mele

Tony Mele (1918—1999) was an advocate for the poor throughout his life. He was committed to the community action spirit of helping others help themselves.

Tony was a founding member of COAD and served as its first chairman in 1971. He was the founder and executive director of the Community Action Program Corporation of Washington-Morgan Counties from its inception in 1966 until his retirement in 1987.

Tony was an active member of the Washington County community, working to ensure that people who were less fortunate than he had a voice at the table.
